

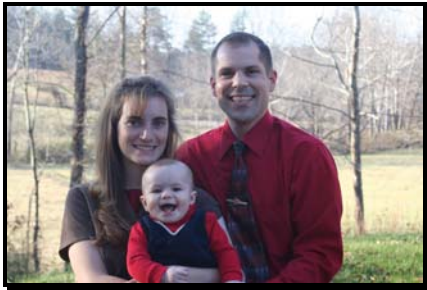

Dear faithful in Christ

Greetings to all in the name that is above every name, the Lord Jesus Christ! First, we want to say thank you for all your prayers and financial giving this year. Secondly, may the Lord bless you all as you enjoy this Thanksgiving 2008.

We just finished an east coast preaching tour. Starting in the south I preached at the University of South Carolina where I was forced off the campus to the adjoining street sidewalk. Thankfully there were plenty of students there. The gathering student body was very attentive and I enjoyed having a number of Christian students join me to help witness. I am looking forward to meeting up

with them again in the next couple of weeks.

North Carolina State University in Charlotte is a great school to minister at if you are ever in



the area. Not only are there a lot of students that gather here but there is a free speech area with no registration issues. The university has posted a large permanent plaque with the First Amendment on it. While here I dealt with a couple of female Muslim students. They told me that we serve the same God. I disagreed. I said the Koran tells us Ala has no son. It also tells us that Jesus was a true prophet and the Gospels of Jesus are true. They agreed. I explained that the God of the Bible has a son and Jesus said he was the “Son of God” therefore there is a contradiction in the Koran. One of the ladies responded saying the Bible was in error. I told her she just agreed the Koran puts its approval on the Gospels of Jesus. In the Gospels, Jesus said he was the way the truth and the life and that no one cometh to the Father

but by him. He also said he was the Son of God. She responded saying her Koran has never been changed like the Bible. I explained that there are NO originals or copies of the Koran to compare if it has changed because they have been purposefully destroyed. I also explained to her that we have many copies of our manuscript to compare and it has NOT been changed. After hearing this she decided that this was all she could take of the truth and left while calling for her friend to come with her. Her friend much to her and my surprise stayed to listen. Amen! I had an hour long conversation with a student who was from the Ukraine. I gave his phone number along with two other students to the local church in that area. Pray for them and the rest of the students that heard the Word.

The next stops were, North Carolina State University in Greensboro, Winston-Salem State University and then Wake Forest University. This is a beautiful University. This wealthy private university is a good place to pass out tracts though I couldn't find any hub where the students congregated.

We went to the famous Duke University in Durham NC. I was able to run into a few theological majors who were

willing to talk a while. Josiah was the one who gave out the most tracts that day. Who could refuse this little face? He was so happy to pass them out eagerly waiting for the next person to come by.



In Virginia we blew out my front tire in the middle of the night. We thank the Lord that we were able to replace two of our tires with just a little additional cost and that he protected us through it all.

I met up with some of my preacher friends in Pennsylvania. Amy and Josiah were able to stay at a nice mission house to rest up and fellowship with some ladies of the church. This makes a good spot tell you we are expecting our second baby at the end of May. Please keep this in your prayers.

While in PA traveled to Shippensburg University were one week later Sarah Palin spoke. It wasn't long after I started preaching that the crowd exploded from just a few students to a couple hundred. For about 5 hours it was not politics but preaching that held this crowd together. One female student said, "God is dead, and, "there is no God." I asked her for her evidence and to prove it.

"What proof do you have?" I said. She could not give any. Amen! I have been keeping in touch with a student there named Adam. He believes baptism is necessary for salvation. Please pray as we continue to speak together.

While I was preaching on the murder of abortion at Indiana University PA., one female student cried out, "I can do what I want with my body!" I told her, "if you want to cut your leg, arm, or your head off go ahead; it's your body, but don't cut the baby's leg, arm, or head off because it's not your body it's the baby's. I could see the light bulb come on as she realized the truth that a baby was another body inside her body. Upon hearing this she left, having nothing to defend.

Lock Haven University was fabulous. The administration was not happy with us being there and they posted two



officers next to me the whole time. The crowd of students were enormous here.

After visiting Penn State University, Millersville University PA, Kutztown University PA, Ulster County Community College in NY, I ended up at Salem State College in Massachusetts. Here a group of students followed me out to the side walk to continue listening to me preach after being kicked off. Amen!
