Greeting to all those of like precious faith in Christ Jesus. We waited a little longer to send out this letter because we wanted to give you the conclusion on a few pressing matters before us. We have therefore cut this letter short on testimonies to update you with this different information plus a major opportunity to our ministry.

First of all, in regards to our motor home, we did not win outright. The arbitrator ruled that



it was not out of service for more than 30 days. We do not know how he ever could have misunderstood this plain fact but he did. The mechanic testified they had the motor home all summer. The manufacturer did however agree to fix it for us and followed through on his promise. They fixed the air, heat, hot water, fridge, starting/battery problem etc. They also repaired our compartment door that I had personally damaged. Amen! The only thing that was not fixed was the washer & dryer. The board is bad and will cost us about

\$320.00 to fix it. Thank you all so much for your prayers in this matter. Now that we have a clear conscience that the M.H. is problem free, we are planning on selling it as soon as possible. We will explain why later but for now please pray to this end. Thank You.

Secondly, my Schenectady case that was appealed by the city was heard on the 16th of this month. It may be sent back before the federal Judge who originally ruled in the matter. The Judge ruled that the city was liable but did not describe why. The city argued that they should not have to pay for the case. My case was a landmark decision and this does not change it, the city just doesn't want to own up to their fare share of the payout. My attorney's fees are just under \$200,000.00 on this case. As a reminder I did not and will not collect one cent from this case. It all goes into the attorney coffers. I do not believe the federal judge will rule any



differently he will just explain why he felt the city was liable. I believe this will be over all good news. The case however could be

decided by the three panel judges. It is uncertain how they will rule. Hopefully all this will strengthen our case even more but we shall have to wait to see. Please continue to keep this matter in prayer.

Before I leave you with our last news let me pause for some of our ministries travels. It has been a super busy schedule for us since campuses have opened. We ministered in NY at SUNY, New Paltz, in Indiana at Goshen College, and The University of South Bend, in Illinois at the University of Illinois Chicago, Northeastern University, and Chicago University, in Michigan at Eastern University, and



Michigan State University, in Tennessee at the University Of Tennessee, in Ohio at Ohio State University and in Pennsylvania at Clarion State University.

The crowds at times were very large and I thank the Lord for drawing so many to hear His glorious Word preached. No gimmicks, no pizza, no sports, no giving out money, no band music, no name calling, nothing but the Death, Burial, and Resurrection of Christ and His absolute final authority preached with

conviction, compassion and the love of Christ for blind sinners.

There were many Muslims who came out against us while in Chicago. I have noticed in the last eight years the campuses have been increasingly flooding with Islamic students. There were at least three Muslim students that were really confounded and



shaken in their faith. One student lives right down the street from the church I took out to the campus that day. Please pray for them because they live in fear of their family and other Muslims. They have to come secretly because it is very dangerous for them if anyone found out. A former Muslim student showed up when he heard me preaching to these Muslims. He bore a powerful testimony to the crowd explaining how his eyes were opened to the truth. Being one of their kind you could see this greatly impacted them. MI State University is not very conducive to open air preaching because it is so spread out. Josiah Amy and I distributed many tracts and had good one on one witnessing. We thank the Lord for the souls that were saved and those that heard though these travels.

Lastly, for about a year now and most recently in our previous prayer letter we asked everyone to be praying for a place for us to localize our ministry. I set my face to seek the Lord's will by prayer and fasting. I spent the next 40 days on a water fast.



Desperate moves call for desperate measures. At the end of my 40 day fast the Lord opened many doors and gave us a peace in this and other matters. We are confident that the Lord is allowing us to minister in Knoxville, TN. We particularly plan to minister at the University of Tennessee. There are a number of free speech areas on campus. The university has over 27,000 students enrolled here.

We have found a great independent Baptist Church in the area. Our home church has been directing and praying with us about this decision and is now rejoicing with us in this news. Lord willing we will make this our new home church. There are several other solid Baptist churches here that are excited about me training them to minister at the different area campuses. I also met with a leading creationist in the area and Lord willing we will be planning creation seminars among other outreaches to the students. U.T. is a strong hold for the evolution



theory. It was at U.T. that "Darwin Day" was started.

I had a private meeting with the Chief of Police at U.T. The Chief was very interested in us ministering to the officers here and asked me about starting an outreach for their troubled students. The Chief introduced me to the Captain who gave me his personal cell phone number. Amen! There are over 60 police officers not including other staff who work for the police department on campus.

Campus outreach here went very well here. There are lots of opportunities. The Neyland Stadium, located on The University of Tennessee campus, is the second largest collegiate stadium in the United States with a seating capacity of over 104,000. We are very excited about how this has all come together. This will put us in a great central location to travel out to the other campuses to help churches start college ministries. There is virtually no outreach here at the present. In the near future we should be flooding this campus with many other church workers on a regular basis. We will need your constant prayer and continued support for this endeavor. Please pray that the devil will not get any strong holds in our lives to destroy these great opportunities. Please continue to pray for our family, finances and ministry.

We are enjoying our two blessings from the Lord. Josiah is having fun preaching and singing. He must be watching me. Joseph is just a bundle of smiles, cooing, and kicking his feet.
